OneJAIN Lifetime Achievement Award - Guidelines

The “OneJAIN Lifetime Achievement Award” will recognise a Jain member of the community resident in the UK who has made significant contributions to the community and/or Jain way of life.

Community Organisations are requested to put forward nominations for this award. We are looking for nominations for those individuals who have over a significant period of their life provided services to the Jain community in the UK or made significant contributions to promote and further the Jain way of life through their voluntary efforts. The nominee should however still be active in their work and services and so examples of projects and initiatives undertaken by the nominee should be from within the last 5 years.

We are confident that all organisations will be able to nominate an individual that meets this description.

To give your nomination the best chance of success, please follow some of the tips outlined here:

- Keep your answers to the questions in the Nomination form brief and succinct, but provide sufficient information
- Focus on recent examples of projects and roles undertaken in the last 5 years.
- Highlight the impact that the work or project has had on people or the community
- Be specific about the work the nominee has done rather than the work the team/committee has achieved. If the contribution is about leading the team then focus on the leadership and directions provided.
- As we are focusing on those individuals who have made significant contributions to the community and/or Jain way of life, it should be noted that simply being a member of a committee or a team for a number of years would not demonstrate this contribution. Therefore please ensure that you highlight projects or initiatives undertaken that went over and above the expected duties of the role performed in the committee or team.

Nomination Submissions:

Nominations should be received no later than **20 January 2018**.

We recommend submitting the form by email to ensure timely receipt, however we have also provided a postal option on the form. If submitting by post, please ensure all your text is visible on the print out.
